Footnotes

BRIGHT KNIGHT showed speed along the inside, drew off around the turn, then remained well clear to the wire under steady pressure. SAILING CLEAR reserved off the pace, raced four wide around the turn and closed to be up for the place while no match for the winner. TRES PATINES tracked the pace along the inside, angled three wide for room midway of the turn, then couldn't keep pace with the winner and was edged for the place. IMPERIAL'S CATCH raced with the early pace three wide, chased the winner off the rail to midway of the turn, then gave way. ROYAL JOKESTER failed to menace. IMAGE OF

ALYDAR off slowly, was not a factor. DENNIS' WORLD was outrun after hesitating and ducking in sharply at the start. FIRE FALLS pressed the early pace outside BRIGHT KNIGHT, moved to the inside on the turn to chase that rival to midway of the turn, then tired. RUN WILKO RUN showed little. RUNRICORUN was done early and eased in the final eighth. KAMINSKI showed brief speed, faded and was eased in the stretch run.
