Footnotes

TYLER'S WILDCAT chased the pace off the rail, eased out for the stretch run, rallied to gain a slim lead inside the eighth pole, then edged away late. RUN SMART ONE tracked the pace, rallied three wide to engage POSITIVE ACTION soon after entering the far turn, vied with that rival to inside the eighth pole, responded when headed by TYLER'S WILDCAT, then weakened late. HIGH BRASS rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and closed with a mild response for the show while drifting to the inside. BRAVE APACHE eased back on the first turn to stalk the pace along the inside, angled out for the stretch run and had no late response. POSITIVE ACTION broke a step slowly, moved up to gain the lead, set the pace along the inside, responded when challenged by RUN SMART ONE on the far turn, vied with that rival to past the eighth pole, then gave way. BRUCE N AUTUMN stalked the pace into the far turn and tired.
