**Footnotes**

SPRITOFSTORM sprinted to a clear lead racing off the rail, made the pace into the stretch, then drifted out late and held on. COMMENCE FIRING allowed to settle after breaking slowly, saved ground around the turn, was caught in traffic when she eased out in early stretch, came inside a rival to find room and was gaining on the winner at the finish. BELIEVEINTHEMOMENT chased the pace into the stretch and weakened. COSMIC CROWN reserved off the pace, raced four wide around the turn and didn't do enough late. BACK BAYOU rated off the pace after hitting the gate at the start, steadied to avoid running up on rivals soon after entering the turn, eased to the inside while remaining in contention into the stretch but had no response when asked. COME SEE COME SA bobbled at the start and was not a factor. STREET FLEET chased the pace three wide around the turn, then tired. MONGOS EXPRESSION broke awkwardly, raced five wide and faltered. LOVEYSLOOKINGOOD chased the pace off the rail into the turn, then faded. EDISTO LADY saved ground and was done early.
