Footnotes

FAMOUS FROLIC unhurried after being checked from tight quarters on the first turn, raced three wide around the far turn and rallied under pressure to be up in the final strides. TALENTED PRINCE chased the pace, moved up engage DUNEMOOR on the far turn, vied with that rival into the stretch, opened a clear lead nearing the eighth pole, then ducked out late under left handed pressure and couldn't resist the winner. I'MROYALLYMECKE'D rated off the pace after being steadied on the first turn, advanced to loom a threat in midstretch but didn't do enough late. DUNEMOOR set the pace along the inside, responded when challenged by TALENTED PRINCE, vied with that rival around the far turn and into the stretch, then tired. FLAMINGO RED prompted the pace outside DUNEMOOR for a half mile, then faltered. BIRD OF PARADISE was done early.
