Footnotes

WILD REVENGE tracked the pace along the inside, slipped through at the top of the stretch to gain command, then drew off under a hand ride. CLOUDY well placed early, eased back racing down the backstretch, raced three wide around the far turn, then angled out and closed to prove second best while unable to match strides with the winner. ROCK GOD set the pace off the rail, responded when challenged racing down the backstretch, maintained a slim advantage to the top of the stretch, then tired. TOTAL REWARD unhurried early, saved ground and couldn't keep pace with the top ones. SCOTTISH COAST was not a factor. PICO BOLIVAR stalked the pace, made a run down the backstretch to try the leader three wide to the top of the stretch, then faltered. KRIS AND ME stalked the pace four wide, made a run to join the leaders briefly racing down the backstretch and into the far turn, then faded.
