NUMB LIPS unhurried early, angled four wide on the far turn, then rallied to catch CASH RULES at the sixteenth pole and won going away. CASH RULES stalked the pace off the rail, made a run with LIBERTY CAP to gain a slim lead in the stretch but was no match for the winner late while continuing on with good courage to prove second best. LIBERTY CAP rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, rallied leaving the far turn to reach near even terms for command with CASH RULES, then tired in the drive. OLIGARCH set the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch and faltered. DUCDUC failed to menace. SKY VENTURE chased the pace into the far turn and faded. DEVON ROCK saved ground and dropped back. WINGEDLIE raced four wide and was through after six furlongs.
