D'NIED PERMISSION chased the pace three wide, rallied to engage TRIP N RUN at the quarter pole, then dueled with and edged that rival to the wire while just lasting over G. T. TABU. The latter, chased the pace, drifted out in midstretch, then responded to pressure and rallied to just miss. TRIP N RUN showed speed along the inside, responded when challenged by D'NIED PERMISSION at the quarter pole, then dueled with that rival to deep stretch and was edged to the wire. RANDY'S REFLECTION unhurried early, passed tired rivals without threatening. NO CALCETINES chased the pace, then was steadied from between rivals entering the turn and failed to recover. STARSHIP TITAN off slowly, raced three wide and tired. FLOWING MANE was not a factor. ROYAL APOLLO chased the pace along the rail into the turn, then faltered.
