CSABA set the pace along the rail, lost the lead to TWO IS TO MANY racing down the backstretch, moved back up to regain the advantage entering the far turn, made the pace into the stretch, then drew off under a strong hand ride. RAVELO'S BOY reserved off the pace after breaking slowly, swung out for the stretch run and closed to gain the place while no match for the winner. BELLEFIRE stalked the pace three wide to the top of the stretch, then tired. TWO IS TO MANY chased the pace, moved up to gain a slim lead racing down the backstretch, relinquished the advantage entering the far turn, then faltered in the drive. EMPIRE BUILDER stalked the pace four wide to the top of the stretch, then faded.
