DEDICATED TO BOB sprinted to a clear lead racing off the rail, increased his margin around the turn, then maintained his advantage to the wire while being kept to the task. THE GOLDEN MONKEY unhurried early, rallied to prove best of the rest while never a threat to the winner. SAINTLY FEELINGS reserved off the pace after breaking awkwardly, saved ground and gained the show. A. J. RULER chased the winner off the rail into the stretch, then tired. CUT AND BURN raced three wide and faltered. MAR BRAVO was never close. LAUGHING ALLTHEWAY well placed early, faded.
