VELVETRY was no factor after being steadied when she ducked in at the start. KOBELLA BEAN was outrun. TAYLOR'S BROOK chased the winner into the stretch and faltered. HI AVIE was done early. RAZZLE DAZZLE GAL showed some early foot, raced three wide on the turn and faded.
