REPUBLICAN stalked the pace, eased out for the stretch run, rallied to gain the lead at the eighth pole, then drew clear under urging. RIGHT ON RENEE quickly moved to the fore, made the pace off the rail into the stretch but couldn't match strides with the winner while clearly best of the rest. ANNIE ROE reluctant to load into the gate, was rated off the pace, swung out for the stretch run and gained the show while no threat to the top ones. SNOW TRIAL stalked the pace, made a run three wide on the far turn to loom a threat entering the stretch, then gave way. SANSANNAH reserved off the pace after being steadied entering the first turn, saved ground into the stretch and tired. ABOVE THE STARS stalked the pace into the far turn, then faltered. SHEHASHIGHOPES was done early and eased in the stretch run.
