OLD TOWN POND forced the pace three wide around the turn, gave way in the stretch run proving to be the best of the rest. GRAND MAGICIAN tracked the speed four wide on the turn and tired turning for home. FAMOUS FROLIC chased the pace, angled in around the turn and faded.
