PARADISE DANCER tracked the pace four wide around the turn, rallied to gain the lead inside the eighth pole and was fully extended to prevail while drifting in. CLASSIC MOON off slowly, chased the pace around the turn, eased out and rallied to be up for the place. B L'S A RUNNER vied for the lead along the inside, edged away in midstretch but couldn't resist the top ones. CASINO GAMBLER rated off the pace, saved ground while advancing to loom a threat in the stretch but couldn't sustain his bid. ENGINERY failed to menace. GUNS DRAWN raced with the pace three wide around the turn and tired. VOLADOR vied for the lead between horses to the top of the stretch, then faltered. GRAND CENTRAL was not a factor. SHEIKH was outrun after breaking a step slowly. DEALING LUCKY off slowly, trailed.
