Footnotes

NERVOUS NELL rated off the pace, rallied three wide to engage RARELY WRONG soon after entering the stretch, then dueled with that rival to deep stretch and prevailed. RARELY WRONG set the pace along the rail, repulsed a bid from UNDISPUTED QUEEN on the far turn, then dueled with NERVOUS NELL through the stretch and held on well while being edged to the wire. BURNING FLIRT allowed to settle, saved ground while advanced around the far turn but couldn't keep pace with the top ones while gaining the show. UNDISPUTED QUEEN stalked the pace, made a run to join RARELY WRONG entering the far turn, tried that rival to the top of the stretch, then tired. IT'S A START outrun early, improved her position without threatening. PASSING was not a factor. GADAMIS raced with the early pace, chased RARELY WRONG down the backstretch, then checked from close quarters entering the far turn, faltered and her rider lost his whip. GENTLE TRIPP was done early. DEPUTY GOJAY showed brief speed, faded and was eased in the final eighth.
