**Footnotes**

IN SPEIGHT OF IT stalked the pace, eased outside MAX'S BEAU in the stretch, rallied to catch that rival inside the eighth pole, then drew away under urging. MAX'S BEAU showed speed along the inside to past the eighth pole, then was no match for the winner while saving the place. WOODLAND unhurried early, raced four wide around the turn and closed to just miss the place while no threat to the winner. BROWN DIRT COWBOY chased the pace off the rail into the stretch and tired. GENERAL GUTI steadied leaving the chute, rushed up along the inside to prompt the early pace, dropped back around the turn and faltered in the drive. HEAVEN'S REWARD chased the pace three wide around the turn and faded. FLYING APPROVAL off slowly, raced wide throughout and trailed.
