Footnotes

LET'S GET LUCKY steadied at the start, moved up quickly to chase the pace three wide, drew even with STARSHIP FLARE at the quarter pole, vied with that rival to the sixteenth pole and prevailed. STARSHIP FLARE broke slowly, moved up quickly to vie for the lead along the rail, responded when challenged by LET'S GET LUCKY on the turn, continued to contest the pace with that rival to the sixteenth pole, then gave way grudgingly. PYRITE MOON reserved early, raced four wide around the turn and closed to gain the show while no threat to the top ones. SWEET XARENI rated off the pace, raced along the rail and passed tired rivals. TWILIGHT TIME outrun after being steadied at the start, improved here position in the drive. SIR JEFFREY IMAGE stumbled and bumped with GREY SCRIPT at the start, then failed to menace while racing wide throughout. GREY SCRIPT allowed to settle after bumping with SIR JEFFREY IMAGE at the start, had no response when asked. ALONG THE RIVER very hard to load into the gate, chased the pace into the stretch and tired. YOUCANCOUNTONME well placed early, raced three wide around the turn and faltered. CHANTY LIGHT vied for the lead outside STARSHIP FLARE into the turn, then faded.
