SHELDONS JET set the pace, increased her margin around the turn and through the stretch under a hand ride. MATTIE KATE, stumbled and bumped at the start, forced the pace, but was no match for the winner while besting the others. HONEY'S WHISPERJET, well placed, steadied on the turn then weakened and returned lame. AWSOME DANCER steadied on the turn and lacked a rally. ONCE AGAIN bumped and checked at the start was no factor. DAWN'A SEZ stalked the pace along the inside and tired. QUEENBROOKE broke awkwardly and was through early.
