TEMO'S DREAM stalked the pace three wide, rallied to gain the lead at the eighth pole, then edged away. HALO'S WHO set the pace off the rail into the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. POST TIME chased the pace along the rail into the stretch and gave way. MEAN SAX tracked the pace into the stretch and weakened. TOO MANY TOYZ rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and had no response when asked. NATHAN RIDGE reserved in striking position off the pace, tired in the drive. WEKIVA WACHEE was no factor after being steadied at the start. NAOS was done early after breaking awkwardly.
