Footnotes

DECISIVE MOMENT pressed the pace outside HAL, gained a slim lead from that rival leaving the turn, responded when headed by GRANDE SHORES at the sixteenth pole and came on again to prevail. GRANDE SHORES rated off the pace, angled three wide on the turn, rallied to gain a slim lead at the sixteenth pole but was outgamed to the wire. SHANKOPOTAMUS chased the leaders off the rail to inside the eighth pole, then gave way. LONGER TERMS DOUG tracked the leaders along the inside into the stretch and tired. REPRIZED HALO saved ground and failed to menace. RICK THE BARTENDER was no factor while racing four wide. HAL set the pace under pressure along the rail, responded when headed by DECISIVE MOMENT, stayed with that rival to the eighth pole, then faltered. THE WACO KID off slowly, was outrun. STRATEGIC DEFENSE showed little. PRIVATE PERSON tracked the leaders four wide around the turn and faded. DOUBLE DOWN BROWN was done early.
