ELUSIVE FOX chased the pace off the rail, rallied to catch D' DREAM at the eighth pole, then drew clear under pressure. D' DREAM showed speed along the inside to the eighth pole, then couldn't stay with the winner while just saving the place. ONESTEPTOGO chased the pace along the rail, lacked room in behind D' DREAM racing into the stretch, angled out and closed to just miss catching that rival for the place. WILD STORM CAT reserved off the pace, angled out and closed with a mild response to just miss the show. FOOLISH HONOR unhurried early, advanced three wide around the turn to reach contention in the stretch but didn't do enough late. WONDER WAY saved ground and failed to menace. JOLTIN' JOE rated off the pace, had no response in the drive.
