Footnotes

WINDOWSOFTHEWORLD bumped with MEAN SAX at the start, showed speed outside HEAVEN'S REWARD, inherited a clear lead when that rival steadied midway of the turn, then was fully extended to prevail. HEAVEN'S REWARD showed speed along the rail, was steadied to avoid getting out into WINDOWSOFTHEWORLD midway of the turn, angled out to chase that rival into the stretch but couldn't gain late while saving the place. NUMBER TWO SON reserved along the inside, altered course outside the leaders in the stretch and was gaining on those rivals at the finish. MEAN SAX allowed to settle after being bumped from both sides at the start, raced four wide around the turn and passed tired rivals. GREATER PEACE tracked the leaders three wide around the turn and tired. IMMENSE STORM bumped with MEAN SAX at the start, then was no threat while racing three wide. TOOLE'S RETURN bumped with BEEN SWAYED at the start, chased the pace three wide around the turn and faltered. IMPERIAL GLITTER was no factor while racing three wide. BEEN SWAYED steadied when he bumped with TOOLE'S RETURN at the start, then steadied again entering the turn and was outrun. RAYO DE LUZ showed little.
