B.'S BRANDY showed speed along the inside, increased her margin on the turn, then was fully extended to prevail. SQUAW'S PROSPECT chased the winner into the stretch and proved second best while unable to get to that rival. REALLY STRIKING reserved off the pace, gained the show while no threat to the top ones. SISTERS DREAM failed to menace after being outrun early. LANCETTE'S WAGER raced four wide on the turn and was not a factor. CRIMSON KISS showed early foot along the rail and faltered. KATE'S KOUKLA off poorly, made a run three wide to reach the attending position soon after entering the turn, then faded.
