SAINT PETE vied for the lead outside SKIBO IN JULY, drew clear in midstretch and remained clear to the wire under pressure. DEFENSE MODE rated off the pace, closed with a mild rally to gain the place. ARI'S PRIDE reserved off the pace after breaking slowly, finished willingly to just miss the place. ULTIMATE CHOICE reserved off the pace, saved ground and passed tired rivals. WESTERN LAWYER showed brief speed, chased the leaders around the turn, then tired. STEEL HAMMER bobbled at the start, raced three wide and never threatened. SKIBO IN JULY vied for the lead along the rail into the stretch, then faltered. THE GREAT ZAMBONI steadied soon after the start and was outrun. NOTALOTATROUBLE chased the pace three wide around the turn and faded. ONE HELLUVA RIDE trailed after being taken up from tight quarters on the backstretch.
