DIAMONDESQUE stalked the pace, rallied to reach even terms for command with JOSH'S BUTTA BUTTA approaching the quarter pole, then dueled with that rival to deep stretch and prevailed. BOSTONIAN CAT reserved along the inside, angled four wide on the far turn, then rallied under pressure to be up for the place while unable to catch the winner. JULIEANNAMO stalked the pace three wide into the stretch, then closed with a mild response while being edged for the place. JOSH'S BUTTA BUTTA set the pace along the inside, responded when challenged by DIAMONDESQUE nearing the quarter pole, then dueled with that rival to deep stretch and weakened. MADAM GRACE unhurried early, gained some ground without threatening. CACHUCHA was never a factor after being pinched back at the start.
