URQUIA unhurried early, circled rivals four wide around the far turn to take over in early stretch, then drew off. DEVINING set the pace along the inside, responded when CHARM CAT moved to the fore on the far turn and continued with the good courage to gain the place while no match for the winner. CHANNEL ELEVEN tracked the leaders three wide into the stretch, then couldn't keep pace with the winner while gaining the show. ARIEL'S FLYER stalked the pace off the rail to the top of the stretch, then tired. CHARM CAT chased the pace three wide, moved to take over on the far turn, made the pace into the stretch, then faltered. ANTIA was not a factor. GOLDEN ORCHARD stalked the pace three wide, then pulled up on the far turn and was vanned off.
