COMPUTER DIANA chased the pace, rallied to catch LADY NONNA nearing the quarter pole and drew clear under urging. MAGNIFICENT MATTY rated off the pace, split rivals in the stretch and closed to prove second best. LADY NONNA showed speed along the inside to past midway of the turn, then gave way. LANCETTE'S WAGER reserved early, advanced three wide around the turn to reach contention, then tired in the drive. ABBY CAN DO allowed to settle, raced four wide on the turn, then faltered. MISS IDA BELLE was not a factor. MOVED was done early. SAFLEY'S SOCIAL tracked the leaders around the turn and faded.
