LINCOLN'S BULLET raced with the pace between horses around the turn, then drew off when set down for the drive. CLOUDSOVERJOHN reserved early, saved ground and closed to gain the place while no match for the winner. MOREAPPLAUSEPLEASE vied for the lead outside COPPERCAT LEGACY into the turn, moved to the inside on the turn when that rival dropped back while continuing to contest the pace, then tired in the drive. CATALINA EXPRESS vied for the lead three wide around the turn and faltered. COPPERCAT LEGACY showed speed along the rail, dropped back around the turn, angled out and couldn't keep pace with the top ones. EVIL EMPIRE showed early foot and faded. THANK YOU AMERICA was not a factor. STERO was outrun. MOONGLIDE trailed.
