**Footnotes**

TOUGH LOOK vied for the lead between horses to inside the eighth pole, then edged away under pressure. LET ME DOWN EASY broke a step slowly, moved up quickly to vie for the lead three wide to inside the eighth pole, then couldn't stay with the winner while clearly second best. WISE BLITZ chased the pace, angled four wide on the turn, rallied to gain a brief lead at the eighth pole, then weakened. SOLAR D'ORO rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run, advanced to loom a threat in midstretch, then gave way. MR. FOXY showed early foot, dropped back three wide around the turn and had no response when asked. EVERYDAYISAGIFT vied for the lead along the inside into the stretch, then tired. WHATSUPNOTMUCH reserved off the pace, raced four wide around the turn and faltered. FAVORITE PRANK off slowly, was outrun. HEZANELITE saved ground and faded. ARTICIFER was no factor after being steadied from between rivals nearing the end of the backstretch.
