Footnotes

KINGS OVER rank under restraint in the early going, angled out for the stretch run, was rallying when bumped hard by BROTHER PAT inside the sixteenth pole, recovered and closed to be just up at the wire. BROTHER PAT was racing with the early pace four wide when eased back racing down the backstretch, advanced four wide around the far turn to reach contention, then was knocked into KINGS OVER in deep stretch while rallying to just miss. ALL KNIGHT set the pace along the inside to deep stretch, then drifted out under left-handed pressure bumping BROTHER PAT soundly and was caught by the top ones at the wire. MUCHO MAS MACHO rated off the pace, advanced along the rail around the far turn to reach contention, then lacked room in behind ALL KNIGHT in the stretch, got through and closed to also just miss. NIAM'S STRIKE allowed to settle, saved ground and closed late without threatening. STAR OF SARAVA prompted the pace outside ALL KNIGHT into the stretch and weakened. STORM WARNINGS chased the pace three wide to the top of the stretch, then gave way. BURNING TIME failed to menace. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE BUMPING INCIDENT IN DEEP STRETCH. NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
