Footnotes

TROUBLES COMIN stalked the pace, was steadied in traffic on the turn, eased out and rallied to gain the lead at the eighth pole, then drew clear. HOLLYWOOD LEFT reserved off the pace, raced four wide around the turn, rallied to loom a threat in midstretch but couldn't stay with the winner while holding the place. LAWNWOOD unhurried after breaking slow, checked in traffic on the turn, then closed to just miss the place while unable to stay with the winner. SMALL TOKEN outrun early, angled out in the stretch and finished willingly. THE CHILL ZONE vied for the lead three wide to the eighth pole, then gave way. RETIRE TO WHAT vied for the lead along the inside to the eighth pole, then tired. PURELY PRECIOUS vied for the lead between horses, then was fading when steadied on the turn.
