ALTAMAR pressed the pace along the inside, moved to take over on the turn and drew well clear, then was fully extended to hold NORMA CLAIRE safe. The latter, reserved racing along the inside, eased out in the stretch and closed the gap on the winner without threatening. BRYCE'S GIRL unhurried early, angled out for the stretch run and finished willingly for the show. BOOGIE WOOGIE tracked the pace, raced four wide around the turn and didn't do enough late. ACT OF BLUES saved ground and failed to menace. CHANTILLY G. tracked the leaders off the rail around the turn and had no response when asked. DIBS ON DEBBIE was outrun. CIAO BELLISSIMA showed speed off the rail into the turn and faltered.
