SIMPLY SPLASHING rated off the pace, rallied three wide leaving the far turn, took over approaching the eighth pole and drew clear under urging. WATAFLEET MISS well placed while saving ground, was steadied when caught in tight trying to get outside KELLY BAG in early stretch, then closed to prove second best. JEBLETTE unhurried while saving ground, angled out at the top of the stretch and closed to be up for the show while unable to keep pace with the top ones. KELLY BAG made the pace along the rail into the stretch and weakened. ALL BEST WISHES outrun early, angled to the inside on the far turn and passed tired rivals. REIMA ROSE failed to menace. STORM LASS stalked the pace, made a run at the leader racing into the stretch, then tired in the drive. LIFETIME stalked the pace into the far turn and faltered. TRIXIE DIXIE was through after a half mile. ARDENT LOVER showed nothing.
