DONT SAY NO SIERRA tracked the pace four wide around the turn, rallied to gain the lead at the eighth pole and was fully extended to prevail. FROSTY ROYALTY chased the pace, rallied to take over at the quarter pole but couldn't resist the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. FAST LISA off slowly, chased the leaders three wide around the turn and weakened. ALISA'S HOPE rated off the pace, advanced four wide around the turn to reach contention but had no late response. WISE BRIANA ducked in at the start, saved ground around the turn and tired. IRISH CLASS raced three wide and faltered. DIG FOR DINNER broke slowly, then steadied in traffic on the backstretch and was not a factor. OUT OF LINE was outrun. TEXAS GUINAN showed speed along the rail to the quarter pole and faded.
