NATHAN RIDGE outrun early, angled out on the far turn, circled rivals four wide to take over entering the stretch, then drew clear under pressure. NEVERI rated off the pace, advanced three wide around the far turn to reach even terms for command entering the stretch but couldn't match strides with the winner while clearly second best. DANCING CALLING stalked the pace along the rail, was steadied when unable to get through inside STRAIGHT MONEY MAN approaching the quarter pole, angled out and wore that rival down to be up for the show while unable to keep pace with the top ones. STRAIGHT MONEY MAN set the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch, then gave way. BANDIT PRINCE tracked the pace into the far turn and tired. UNSEPARABLE chased the pace three wide, made a run at the leader on the far turn, then faltered. LLEVATELO saved ground and dropped back. SERAPI CAT was outrun. STARSHIP VOYAGE showed little after breaking awkwardly. TIME FOR TRUTH chased the pace, made a run to try the leader racing down the backstretch and into the far turn, then faded.
