**Footnotes**

BINGO BANGO BONGO tracked the pace, angled out and rallied to gain the lead just inside the eighth pole, then was all out to last over GREEN LITE SPECIAL. The latter, rated off the pace, steadied when caught in tight entering the far turn, advanced in behind rivals into the stretch, angled in for room and rallied to just miss. PICO BOLIVAR chased the pace, eased out and rallied to gain a brief lead at the eighth pole, then weakened. STORM CHART unhurried after being steadied soon after the start, angled out in the stretch and finished willingly. BARBARO'S REVENGE reserved off the pace, steadied to avoid running up on rivals on the far turn, then gained some ground without threatening. THE BEST GLACIER steadied from close quarters soon after the start and failed to menace while gaining ground late. MZ'S DON ZULON vied for the lead outside SASTRE into the stretch, gained the advantage from that rival, then was tiring when steadied in behind GREEN LITE SPECIAL at the sixteenth pole. SASTRE vied for the lead along the rail into the stretch and faltered. PERSONAL PSYCHIC was no factor while racing three wide. VANISHING BUCK steadied in the early going, was saving ground when steadied again on the backstretch and faded. The rider of MZ'S DON ZULON lodged an objection against the rider of GREEN LITE SPECIAL for alleged interference at the sixteenth pole. The claim of foul was not allowed.
