### Footnotes

CASH ADVANCE showed speed along the rail, responded when challenged by GLADDING on the first turn, then dueled with that rival to wire and prevailed. GLADDING bobbled at the start, moved up on the first turn to engage CASH ADVANCE, then dueled with that rival and continued on gamely while being edged to the wire. CARLY'S REAL DEAL unhurried early, raced four wide around the far turn and closed with a belated rally to be just up for the show. VANISHING BUCK stalked the pace into the stretch but didn't do enough late. JUPITER rated off the pace after being caught in tight early, gained some ground without threatening. CASH US NOW bumped with ACAPELLA CHAMPION at the start, was rank in the early going, while moving up to race in striking position into the stretch, then had no response when asked. BLACK TIE SPIRIT steadied from close quarters in the early going, was saving ground when steadied again on the far turn and failed to menace. GUIDING SPIRIT was done early. ACAPELLA CHAMPION was no factor after being bumped and checked from between rivals at the start. TASSO'S AFFAIR bumped with ACAPELLA CHAMPION at the start, steadied in behind rivals on the first turn, rushed up on the backstretch to reach contention, then faded on the far turn.
