SIGNOR MARTINI was angled in soon after the break and settled back off the dueling leaders, quickly gained leaving the five sixteenths marker, shifted out into the stretch, split rivals under strong left handed urging past the eighth pole, forged to command a sixteenth out and drew clear. TRULY MEMORABLE dueled two wide, spurred clear in upper stretch, was headed near the sixteenth pole, faded but managed to save the place. CHILEAN STEP tracked the duel three wide, moved closer into the far turn, chased into the stretch but went evenly the last eighth. FEEL SO GOOD (KOR) briefly went clear early, dueled along the rail from the five eighths pole to the quarter pole then gradually gave way the final furlong. EEK was rated back inside rivals nearing the first turn, settled while in range past the five eighths pole, came under pressure off the rail leaving the far turn but lacked a solid response. CLUTCH , four wide, steadily advanced after a half mile to take aim, chased the leaders to the head of the stretch then gave way in the final furlong. WISE MAKER , wide for the drive, failed to menace. JONATHAN C saved ground without threatening. HONOR SURVI , off slowly, was outrun then was vanned off. WISE MASTER broke a step slow, raced far back and was eased when well beaten.
