DEVIL IN PINK rated off the pace, rallied outside ERIN OF WICKLOW to take over on the far turn, then drew away under urging. ERIN OF WICKLOW set the pace along the inside into the far turn, then was no match for the winner while clearly second best. SISTER GRACIE bobbled at the start, saved ground into the stretch and outfinished the others for the show. SIBERGACE failed to menace. JEB'S LUCKY GIRL was no factor after being outrun early. APPLTRY showed little. ROYAL POWER raced four wide on the far turn while being outrun. GOLDEN COINS steadied when caught in tight entering the first turn, then was through after a half mile. STEPPIN CLEVER prompted the pace into the backstretch, then stopped.
