STARSHIP SHAWTY disputed the pace two wide inside rivals, took command nearing the turn, took pressure from PA PA PA PERFECT to upper stretch, shook clear of that rival under strong left handed urging in mid stretch then held sway the final sixteenth. PA PA PA PERFECT, four wide attending the pace, moved to seriously challenge mid turn, vied outside the winner into the lane, could not go with that one in the final furlong but did save the place. MISS QUISQUEYA broke slowly then pulled its way to contention between rivals nearing the half mile marker, checked sharply off heels and bolted three furlongs out, came extremely wide into the lane, was straightened away for the stretch run and finished with good energy. MISS MARTIN lacked speed, saved ground nearing the stretch, altered out and had some belated interest. LA GIGI stalked the early pace, was taken out very wide by MISS QUISQUEYA when that rival bolted three eighths out, was guided back down to about the three path approaching the stretch, made some progress near mid stretch then flattened out. ON TIME AGAIN chased the pace, saved ground nearing the lane but failed to threaten. WILDCATINJEANS vied early between rivals, chased the leaders mid turn then gave way. Following a stewards' inquiry and objection by the rider of LA GIGI, MISS QUISQUEYA was disqualified from third and placed fifth for causing interference around the turn.
