Footnotes

RUBY BAYOU set a pressured pace inside while under rating, turned back a challenge from BOUND FOR DUTY leaving the quarter pole, responded when shaken up in upper stretch and eagerly widened under a drive. BOUND FOR DUTY stalked the pace, lodged a three wide bid nearing the lane, pressed briefly, continued on willingly and was clearly second best. DANCE COCOA DANCE chased a contested pace while close up inside, angled out in upper stretch but lacked the needed finish. CALL CENTRAL was steadied when in tight at the break, saved ground advancing into the lane, eased out and closed up between rivals leaving the sixteenth marker. BEACH LIGHTNING , in mid pack under a ride, angled out four wide making a mild move nearing the lane then flattened out. COUNTRY ISLE was angled to the rail entering the turn but lacked a rally. A B ALLIEBELLE circled the turn five wide and came up empty. GIBSON'S LIL GRACE disputed the pace outside the winner to the quarter pole and gave way. BEWARE THE STORM , off the rail, raced under some rating to the quarter pole and failed to menace. SWEET ACT lacked speed, angled in nearing the lane, shifted back out but could not threaten.
