Footnotes

INDIANO prompted the pace three wide, came under solid urging mid turn, was floated out five wide while rallying into the lane, forged command approaching the eighth pole and drew clear under a drive. ABDEL'S GHOST accelerated inside rivals to take command, set a quick pace removed from the inside, drifted out entering the stretch, was righted soon after, relinquished the lead leaving the three sixteenths marker but continued on well to be second best. CLOSE IT OUT, in a bit tight at the start, lagged back early while saving some ground, angled out mid turn, split rivals leaving the eighth pole and finished willingly. DUTY BLUES moved up behind rivals in the opening furlong, chased around the turn, worked outward to about the five path but failed to generate the needed response. ARTEFACTO stalked the pace four wide, was ridden along mid turn and weakened through the final sixteenth. TWO IS TO MANY stumbled after being put in tight at the break, lost ground four to five wide when edging closer near the half mile marker, chased around the turn and weakened. ANGELOFDISTINCTION broke a step slow and failed to threaten. KING GHIDORAH came in at the break tightening rivals, dropped in near the five eighths pole to save ground, failed to keep pace and gave way through the drive. LOCH DUBH was outrun inside.
