STRAIGHT FACED bumped by WONDEROUS GLORY at the start, stalked the leader into the stretch, moved to gain command nearing the eighth pole, then drew away while in hand. VILLAINAGE reserved early, raced four wide around the turn and closed to be up for the place while no match for the winner. EL BANDIDO ROJO quickly moved to the fore while angling over to the rail, made the pace into the stretch and gave way. WONDEROUS GLORY unhurried after being jostled between rivals at the start, raced four wide on the turn and closed with a belated rally. DRUMS OF THUNDER raced in striking position to nearing the stretch, then tired. FORTY ZIP tracked the leaders three wide around the turn and faltered. DEFINITELY TRUE failed to menace after being steadied when he bumped with SIR WINSTON at the start. GREEN VEGAS was chasing the pace when he hit the rail entering the turn and dropped back. A BIT OF MADNESS well placed early, raced three wide on the turn and faded. RED LINE steadied from tight quarters on the backstretch, then saved ground to no avail. SIR WINSTON hit the gate and bumped soundly with DEFINITELY TRUE at the start, chased the leaders around the turn, then had nothing left for the stretch run. SWORN TESTAMONY was outrun. JOANNE'S PAULUS stumbled and knocked WONDEROUS GLORY into

STRAIGHT FACED at the start, raced five wide on the turn and stopped.
