Footnotes

GREAT SCOT cleared early, rated kindly two wide, kicked away from challengers when roused leaving the far turn, responded to right handed pressure when well clear in mid stretch and held sway. HOLD THAT CAMERA saved ground while unhurried early, gained momentum nearing the lane, swung out wide in mid stretch and finished well to be gaining at the end. SASSARION saved ground in a forward position, edged closer under a ride into the lane but was outfinished through the final sixteenth. LIQUID LUCK stalked the pace three wide, made a mild move to threaten around the far turn, chased the winner into the stretch and came up empty. FOOLISH TIGER rated in range, advanced between rivals mid way on the final turn, angled out wide for the drive and offered up a mild late rally. SLEW DEM, off the rail, came under a ride leaving the three eighths pole but failed to respond. PLEASANT ALBERT stalked the pace four wide and faltered nearing the quarter pole. MR. GOLD MINE was always outrun.
