Footnotes

TANASI rated back after an alert break, stalked the pace three wide, rallied through a seam entering the lane and collared FLASH MY ANGEL, moved to command near the eighth pole, wandered outward when roused left handed, was corrected with the right stick when clear a sixteenth out then held firm. FLASH MY ANGEL gained command nearing the five eighths pole, set a rated pace in the two path, took pressure from mid turn, relinquished command with about a furlong remaining but stayed on gamely to the end. EVIL QUEEN settled off the pace, angled mid turn, made some progress into the lane, shifted out about five wide in mid stretch and finished with interest. A. J.'S HOT MAMBO prompted the pace four wide, moved to engage the leader around the turn, drifted out five wide allowing the winner through into the lane, chased past the eighth pole then faded. SASSY Q stalked towards the inside, came under pressure mid turn, angled out in upper stretch but lacked a response. C U LATOR WERBLIN bobbed at the break, was angled in near the five eighths pole, was put to a strong ride mid turn, failed to kick in and gave way through the lane.
