Footnotes

WHATSUPNOTMUCH cleared early, set the pace towards the inside, moved away into the lane, came under a strong ride inside the eighth pole, failed to switch leads but had enough left to prevail. TINITUS, pushed inward at the break, was outrun early while towards the inside, angled out leaving the far turn, circled four wide under strong urging into the lane, lugged in under right handed pressure departing the sixteenth marker, continued getting in bothering KAMINSKI and closed the gap. KAMINSKI, forced in at the break, recovered to be sent up towards the inside, advanced under a ride into the lane, angled off the rail mid stretch, bumped with TINITUS leaving the sixteenth pole then was herded in by that rival the final fifty yards. STRONG FIRE bore in at the break crowding rivals, was sent up between foes soon after, prompted the winner to the three eighths pole gave chase into the stretch then weakened a furlong out. ROYAL JOKESTER stumbled outward at the break, lagged back, circled six wide into the stretch and failed to menace. PULPO chased wide and tired. RENEGADE'S SPIRIT broke a step slow, was carried out soon after, rushed up wide to stalk the early pace then faltered between rivals with three eighths to go. Following a stewards' inquiry, TINITUS was disqualified from second and placed third for causing interference to KAMINSKI in the stretch
