**Footnotes**

RUTHLESS REBECCA tracked the speed between horses, angled in and gained command inside the sixteenth pole and edged clear under pressure. PINKMINGO set the pace under pressure off the rail first from DIG FOR DINNER, then RUTHLESS REBECCA in the drive and gave way a sixteenth out. DIG FOR DINNER forced the pace, three wide around the turn and weakened in the drive. SANTASLITTLEHELPER outrun early, raced five deep on the turn and passed tired rivals. MARIMAR LIGHT raced up close while four wide and tired. MISS CASSIE JEAN stalked the pace along the inside and faltered in the drive. MADISON NORTH was allowed to settle, then saved ground to no avail. MISS IDA BELLE trailed.
