IL DIVO chased the pace three wide, moved up to engage MY PAL GRAPPO at the top of the stretch, then edged away from that rival late while being ridden out. MY PAL GRAPPO showed speed along the inside into the stretch, then couldn't stay with the winner late while clearly best of the rest. KITTY LITTER rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and closed to gain the show while unable to keep pace with the top ones. LITTLE STOGIE pressed the pace outside MY PAL GRAPPO around the turn, then tired. DOCTOR GARRETT off slowly, chased the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch, then faltered. JUMBO JUMBO showed early foot and faded. RAINBOW CRUISE was not a factor. WISE EMPEROR broke poorly, then was outrun while racing five wide.
