FOR FILLIES, TWO YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$2,500 each (Stallion) ; \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start August 6. The added money together with all nomination fees, eligibility payments, entry and starting fees to be divided

-Approximately 12.5% of gross purse August 6 after distribution of Stallion Nominator and Breeders' Awards; Approximately 20.5% of gross purse August 27 after distribution of Stallion Nominator and Breeders' Awards; Approximately 66.5% of gross purse

October 15 after distribution of Stallion Nominator and Breeders' Awards. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Stallion and Breeders' Awards to be distributed according to Florida Statute in effect on the date of the race. Weight: 118 lbs.

A trophy will be presented to the winning Owner. Nominations for Stallions closed on February 15, 2008 with 1116 Stallion Nominations. (No Supplementary Nominations). Closed Friday, May 20, 2011 with 442 nominations.

Footnotes

REDBUD ROAD , four wide in range off of a contested early pace, moved boldly mid turn, took command into the lane, drifted in to the two path near mid stretch, dueled and edged clear late under right handed pressure. QUEEN DRAMA settled early, circled four wide advancing near the lane, shifted in slightly in upper stretch, rallied between rivals, drifted out near the sixteenth pole, was straightened away and finished up willingly to get the place. MONTESSA G dueled two wide, edged clear mid turn, was overtaken entering the stretch, dueled inside the winner leaving the eighth pole then checked and altered out when in close in deep stretch. LOTTA LOVIN , between rivals chasing the pace mid turn, altered in a bit in the lane but lacked the needed finish. AWESOME BELLE , three wide between rivals chasing the pace mid turn, altered out five wide in upper stretch and came up empty. SINISTER BREW lacked speed, came four wide for the drive and had some belated action. SWEET AND VICIOUS was ridden along three wide around the turn, angled in for the drive but failed to menace. MY TRULY FAIR dueled inside for three furlongs then steadied when tiring near the quarter pole. An objection by the rider of MY TRULY FAIR against LOTTA LOVIN for alleged interference near the quarter pole was not allowed. There was also a stewards' inquiry into the stretch run but no action was taken
