PAULETTE CAVEAT prompted two wide under confident handling, took over with ease three furlongs out, moved clear approaching the quarter pole, was joined from both sides in mid stretch, dug in tenaciously under left hand pressure and proved best. GLORY PARK angled out four wide nearing the five eighths pole, commenced a run leaving the far turn, moved to near even terms inside the eighth pole, dueled but wasn't quite good enough. APPELLA'S WONDER pulled her way to contention along the rail entering the backstretch, rated close leaving the far turn, challenged inside the winner from the eighth pole but was outfinished. STARSHIP FREEDOM stalked three wide, moved closer between rivals approaching the stretch then went evenly. PLEASURE TO PLEASE settled back in early backstretch, dropped to the rail, moved forward leaving the three eighths pole, angled out mid turn, shifted back nearing the eighth pole but came up empty. JULIET DEAR , nudged along near the half mile marker, raced between rivals leaving the far turn but lacked a rally. MANDATED TO WIN failed to menace. KEY KREW , fractious pre race, drew clear early, set the pace inside, was overtaken three furlongs out and faltered.
