**Footnotes**

TRULY DISTINCTIVE vied inside rivals, took command while being bumped near the three furlong marker, took pressure around the turn, edged clear into the lane, was overtaken near the furlong pole, battled back under right handed pressure and edged back away late. POWER RULES , bumped soon after the break, was angled out three wide past the seven furlong marker, moved to engage the dueling leaders five furlongs from home, dueled, was bumped around the far turn, pressed the winner past the five sixteenths marker, dropped back a bit entering the lane, came back between rivals a furlong out, dueled on near even terms then was outfinished. SIR CHARLIE , bumped just after the start, settled in good position off the rail and off of contested pace, picked up momentum around the final turn, ranged up four wide to join the fray in upper stretch, drifted in when putting a head in front near mid stretch, dueled, drifted out late and hung. STORM CHART , unhurried early, circled four wide into the stretch, shifted out wider but gained mildly. ROCK ALEX dueled two wide, held a short lead between foes past the five eighths pole, eased back when bumped around the far turn, chased around the final turn, steadied nearing mid stretch when attempting to come back then flattened out. UNBRIDLED FUTURE , inside, dropped back. There was a stewards' inquiry into the stretch run but no action was taken
